The Director of Finance reviewed the 2022-23 Audited Financial Statements, included in the meeting materials, reporting that:

82 83 84 The auditor has provided a "clean" opinion, stating that the financial statements fairly present the College's financial position as of July 31, 2023, along with its results of operations and cashflows for the year ending in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations.

• The College's deficit of \$46,123 is expenses over revenue for 2022-2023.
